If you need a journal article, book, or other loanable material that the Little Elm Public Library System does not own, the Library's Interlibrary Loan (ILL) service will attempt to get it for you.

- ◆ Anyone with a Little Elm Public Library card in good standing may request an item through the Interlibrary Loan service
- ◆ You may request or have active five item requests at any one time
- ◆ Anything not owned by the Little Elm Public Library may be borrowed if it is owned by another library that will agree to lend it
- ◆ The following types of material often are **not** available through ILL:
  - Books published within the last 12 months
  - Reference works
  - Computer software
  - Rare materials or original manuscripts
  - Entire volumes or issues of journals and newspapers
- ◆ Since the item may come from anywhere in the United States requests generally take one - three weeks to arrive
- ◆ The item's due date is stated on the Little Elm Public Library Interlibrary Loan tag
- ◆ There are no renewals on ILL materials
- ◆ Usually, there is no charge for the ILL service. However, some libraries do charge for photocopies or to loan materials. In this case, the Library will notify you and ask if you are willing to pay the charge before we finalize the request. Also, you are responsible for any fines and/or replacement costs levied by the lending library that you might incur.

**Please note the loss of Interlibrary Loan privileges may result if:** Two Interlibrary Loans are returned overdue or if two Interlibrary Loans are not picked-up.

### ***How to Create an Interlibrary Loan (ILL) Request in the Texas Group System***

1. Search the Little Elm Public Library Catalog to see if it is available locally.


If it is not:

2. Enter search terms and click search button
3. Select the title you want by clicking on the title
4. Click on the "Request Item" button
5. A new screen will appear: "Choose your home library"
6. Scroll down the list of libraries and select "Little Elm Public Library"
7. Click on "Continue"
8. Enter your library card number in the "username" field
9. Enter the password of your library account in the "password" field
10. Click "login"
11. It is mandatory that you enter an email address and select a pickup location
12. Click on "Continue"
13. Request Successful prompt will appear



## Detailed Instructions – Creating Interlibrary Loan Request (ILL)

1. Go to [www.littleelmlibrary.org](http://www.littleelmlibrary.org). Click Search the Catalog.



2. Click in the Search box, then type a title or author and click GO.
  - a. If the title is not returned click on the tab for "Interlibrary Loan (ILL)" and enter the title in the Search Texas Group Catalog search box. Go to step 3.



- b. Or if the title is returned but not what you need, click "More searches" and Select "Interlibrary Loan"
